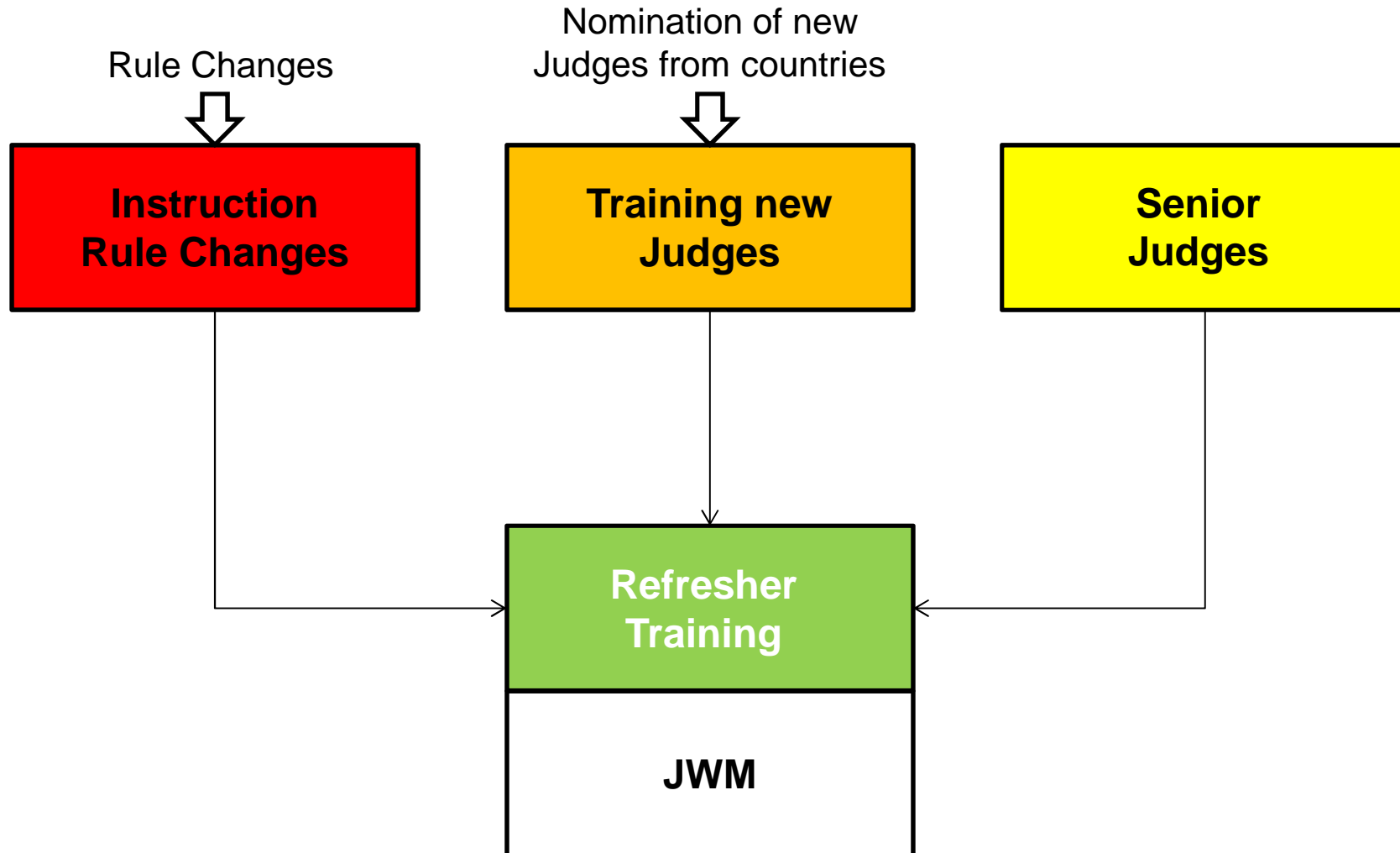

Motivation for new concept

- Reducing preparation- and organization requirements

Instruction Rule Changes

- Communication of those rule changes, relevant to the Judges
- Implementation of rule changes will be developed by the Judge Representative in cooperation with his team leaders static judging and flight judging

➔ *Result: Working-Instructions, Checklists*

Training new Judges (1)

- A lot of competition practice
- A lot of time to practice
- A lot of models in static judging
- A lot of models in flight judging

At a national championship F4 Jet
→ in Switzerland or other countries
(max. 2 people per competition) ⇒ **Waiting list**

Training new Judges (2)

- Theory
 - Half day before competition
 - Static judging and flight judging
 - By Judge Representative or Senior Judge
- Practice
 - One day static judging
 - One day flight judging
- Debriefing
 - After competition (progress check)
 - Trainee writes an experience report to the Judge Representative
 - Delivery of IJMC Judge Licence

Senior Judges

- If possible participation as judge at national championship
 - Primary by IJMC Rulebook
 - Secondary by F4C FAI Rulebook
- Refresher Training
 - Mandatory for nominated Judges
 - Voluntarily for non-nominated Judges
